# “You Only Enroll Twice”

- Why W&M was looking for a new approach
  - Transfer Initiatives
  - Access and Opportunity
- Why this appeals to TNCC, RBC, TCC, and others
  - Student success and retention

# Eliminating the “Dr. No” Syndrome

- Development of the 2+2 Co-Enrollment Agreements between W&M and select VCCS institutions- perspective from both sides
- Begins with Academics
- Ensures Student Support
- Coordinates Student Records

# “Goldfinger”: The Golden Touch

- Marketing the Program at both institutions
  - Students
  - Faculty
  - Administrators
- Faculty and student feedback

# “Stirred, not Shaken” Part 1

- Our Processes
  - Letter of Intent
  - Create “shadow” record at W&M
  - Create official record at TNCC
  - TNCC authorizes enrollment, continuance, courses, etc.

# “Stirred, not Shaken” part 2

- The Student Experience
  - WM and CC advisors work together on advising
  - Dedicated staff at both colleges
  - Orientation at W&M before co-enrollment begins and again at matriculation
- W&M matriculates the student upon completion of co-enrollment (4-5 classes and AA/AS graduation)

# “A View to a Bill”

## Miss Money Penny Says...

- Student Payment at VCCS rate
- Co-enrollment allows them to stay full-time at CC/RBC, which keeps financial aid intact
- At TNCC, the bookstore will order books and students can use FA to cover the cost
- W&M application fee waived

# “For Your Eyes Only”

- Release of info between institutions is part of the Letter of Intent
- We share tracking data and check reports during the semester to ensure that the records match
- Grade reporting

# “Live and Let Die”

- Not for everyone...
- For some students, the “statewide” agreement is better
- Engineering, Health Sciences, Applied Programs, etc.
